4. Participation in the North-East NSS Festival:

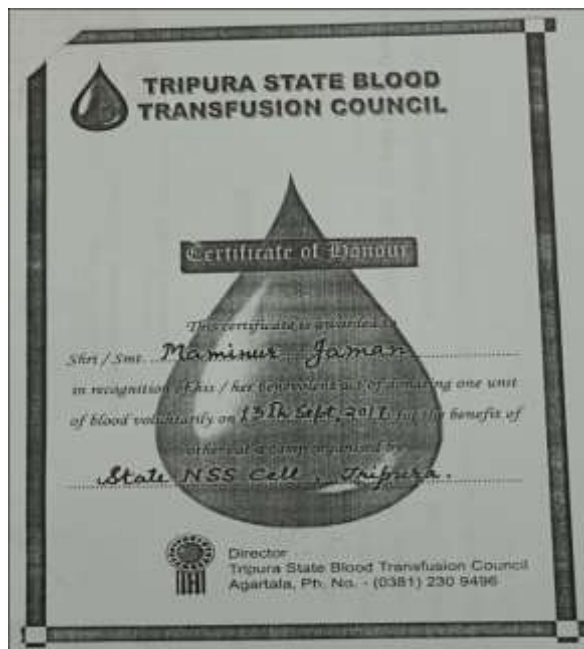
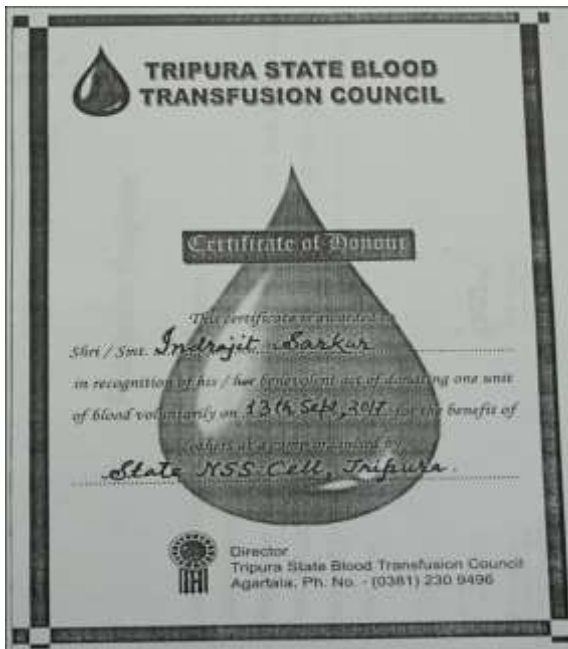
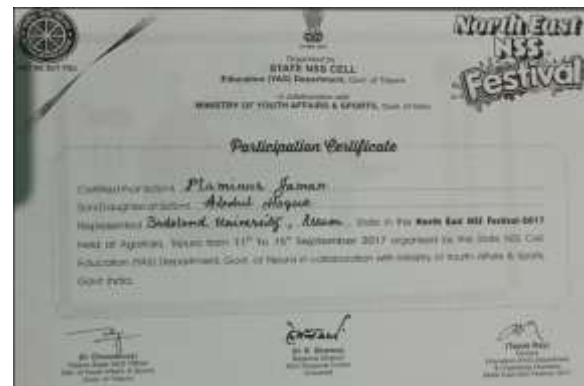

10. Celebration National Unity Day:

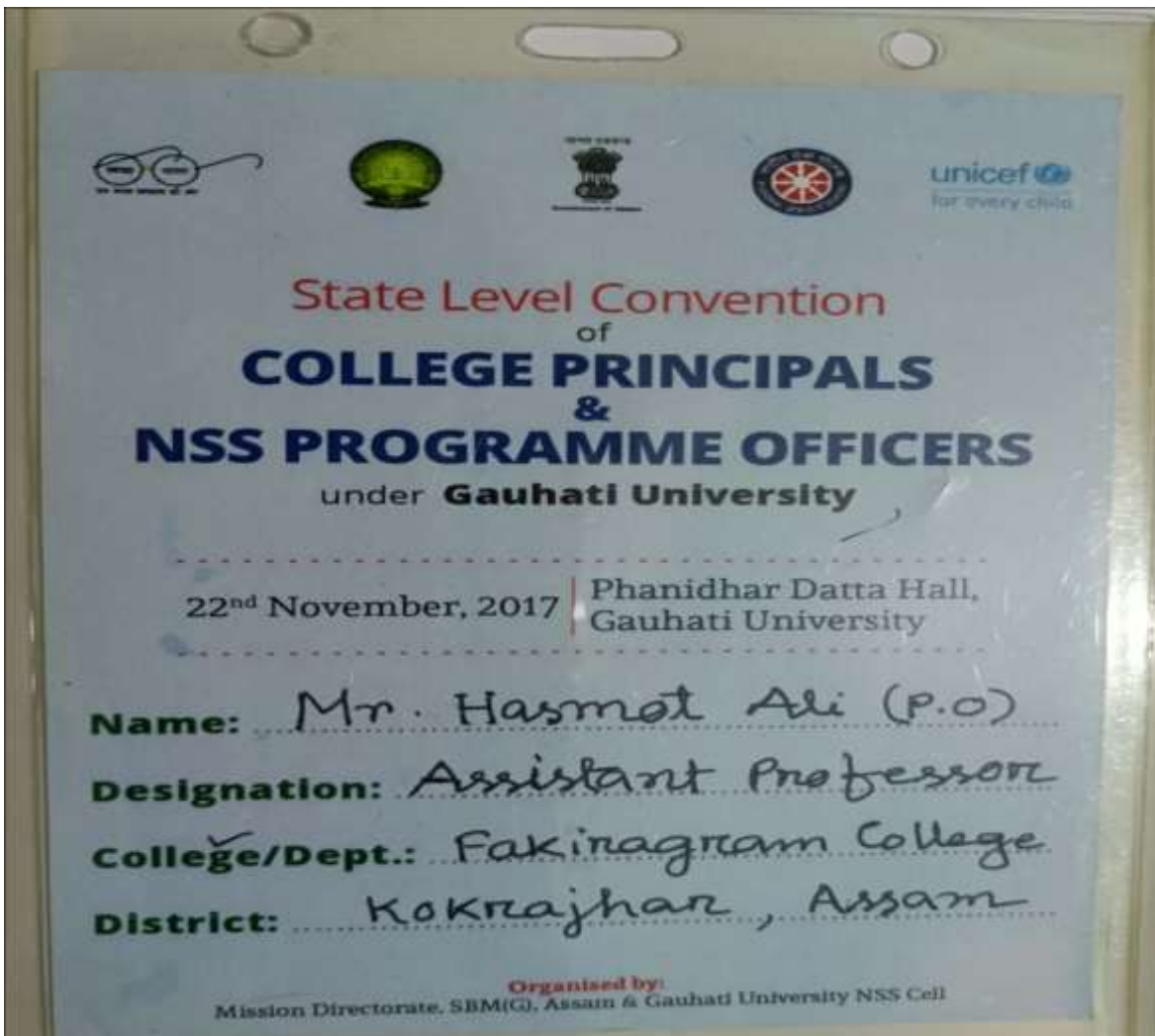

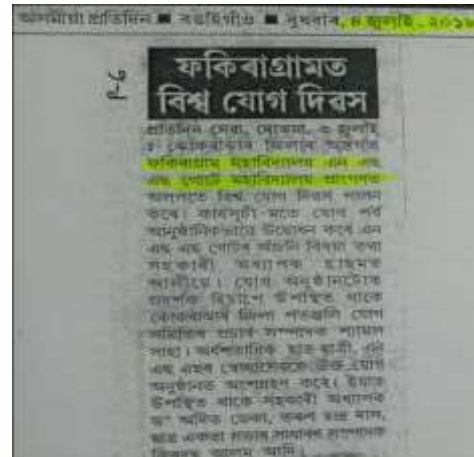
17. Observation of World Environment Day:

20. ACTIVITIES ON SWACHH BHARAT SUMMER INTERNSHIP (SBSI) - 2018

(From 1st July-2018 to 31st July-2018)

1. Motivation cum Orientation Programme: - First of all, we, the NSS Unit started our SBSI activities by organizing motivation cum orientation programme which was held at Fakiragram Public High School on 1st July-2018. There were 200 (two hundred) school students along with NSS volunteers participated in the programme. Mr. C. M. Ahmed, Principal of our college inaugurates the programme and encourages NSS PO & students for their selfless effort. Appointed speaker Dr. Adit Ch. Deka (Assistant professor) gives motivational speech & encourage students and participants for their noble step. Mr. Samaresh Nath, Asstt Prof, Mr. Karmatullah Ahmed, Ex Head Master, Mr. Kamal Kishor Barman, Head Master Fakiragram Public High School along with other teachers attended and gives valuable speech & encourages all to do swachhta activities involving villagers.

After successful end of the motivation cum orientation programme we started an Awareness Rally on swachhta where all school children, some villagers, NSS volunteers participated actively. Fakiragram Police Station provides us sufficient help and co-operation to make the awareness rally successful. We gave the slogans-save water save life, save nature save life, save tree save life etc. etc. First day, we spent more than six hour (9 AM to 300 PM) in awareness campaign.

2. Door to door awareness meeting :- On 2nd & 3rd July volunteers visited door to door to create awareness among villagers on sanitation, Swachhta, health, hygiene, toilet usage & hand washing etc in the adopted village .We visited more than 200 families in two days (2nd & 3rd July). We worked from 9 AM to 3 PM. Our main objectives of the door to door campaign were to motivate the villagers, so that they can contribute to make India clean and healthy.

3. Institution level Swachhta: - After a few days break, on 11th July we started institution level Swachhta campaign. We cleaned the classrooms and school campus of Fakiragram Public High School. NSS volunteers and students of the said school participated in the programme with great interest. We also enjoyed a lot with the school students. That day, we spend about six hour on Swachhta.

4. Wall paintings on Public walls:-To motivated and create public awareness on swachhta we started wall paintings on public walls/govt. building on 12th & 13th July. We spend 6+6=12 (Twelve) hour within this two days.

5. Swachhta Mela: -_On 14th July-2018 we organized a colourful Swachhta Mela at the adopted village where above 100 (one hundred) school children alongwith some guardians participated with great interest. There were various meaningful & colourful programme in the Mela-like Art competition among school children on Swachhta, exhibition of Arts made by our volunteers, showing motivational vedios, prize & certificates distribution, playcard exhibition on Swacchta etc. We invited some local social activities to the Open Session, Mr. C.M. Ahemd, Principal of our college, Mr. Krishna Nath, a reputed teacher, Ajibar Rahman, Asstt. Head Master, FKM Public High School, Mr. Shiv Sankar, Principal, Dream Flower English Medium School etc attended the same. It was really a motivational and thought provoking programme.

6. Free Coaching Class: - From 15th to 19th July (5 days) we spend on free coaching class for the students of Fakiragram Public High School. Our main objective of the coaching classes was to provide basic knowledge on various subjects. We also gave importance on the development morality of the student's .We spent about 30 hours in five days.

7. Rehanshal on Street play: - On 20th July-2017 our volunteers practiced street play.

8. Performance of street play /drama: - On 21st July-2018 we performed street drama/play to aware the people on Swachhta. There was a big public gathering along with school children during the time of drama. Our volunteer tried to give a strong & motivational message to the people, so that they can aware in various issues like, importance of hand washing, bad effects of drinking alcohol, responsibility of public to make India clean, bad effects of the use of plastic bags etc.

9. Street cleaning:-On 22nd July 2018 we started cleanliness drive at the adopted village. Our volunteers cleaned both sides of a few small road/ street. Some villagers participated with us.

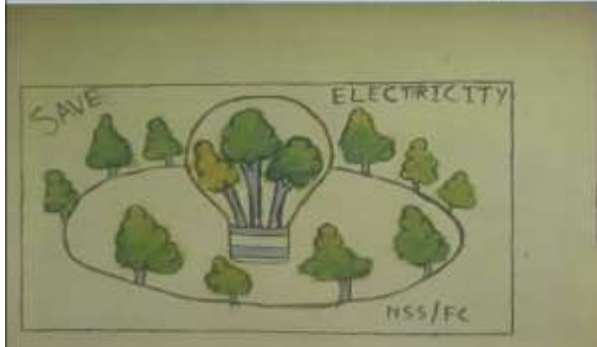
